You must be a Narcoa member, have Narcoa insurance, and have passed the rules test. All operators and passengers must wear a safety vest/shirt while on railroad property. There is plenty of parking for your autos, truck, trailers, and RVs. A mobile VHF radio is strongly encouraged.
